Directors elected to serve in regions 1, 4 and the At-Large position will serve a (3) three-year term. Directors elected to serve in regions 6 and 9 will serve a (4) four-year term. The term lengths are part of the Board Transition Plan that was approved as part of the merger of Lone Star Ag Credit and Ag New Mexico, Farm Credit Services. The Board Transition plan is to ensure consistent rotation in Board seats in accordance with Farm Credit Administration (FCA) regulations. Board of Director meetings are typically held monthly.

Nominating Committee members and alternates serve one-year terms and generally meet four times.
